

## North Hampshire Quilters Block of the Month

Each block will be a 12 inch finished block

### January 3-D Star

Please read through all instructions before starting your block.

#### Fabric Requirements:

You will need four different coloured fabrics and the background fabric.



#### Cutting (all measurements are in inches):

Cut two triangles from each fabric - one large and one small, or, one medium and one small:

- For the Large triangle cut  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " square into half. (C)
- For the Smaller triangle cut  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square into half. (B)
- For Medium triangle cut  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square into half. Please note that the medium triangle should be the same size as the background fabric, so if you like, cut that one first, then just cut a triangle off the same size. (A)
- Background fabric cut one large square  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut into 4 crossways. (A)
- And 4 squares  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". (D)

#### Joining instructions (see also photo of finished block):

Hint: Since we are joining fabric cut on the bias, spray starch your fabric to help stop it stretching

1. Join triangles A to background fabric A
2. Join triangle B to background fabric A
3. Join the triangles A to triangle C
4. Now join the background squares D to the pieced A and B rectangle.
5. Now make up your square.

Hint: Try to make sure your points at the tips are there. Use a pin to match up your points in the middle.
