

North Hampshire Quilters Block of the Month

March - Everest peak

12 inch finished

Please read through all instructions before starting your block.

Fabric Requirements:

I have made this block using three blues and lights but you can change the colour choices.



Cutting (all measurements are in inches):

- A - Cut 1 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square from light or background fabric
- B - Cut 4 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square from coloured fabric
- C - Cut 4 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square from light or background fabric
- D - Cut 4 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square from coloured fabric
- D - Cut 1 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square from light or background fabric
- E - Cut 1 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips at least 12 inches long from both types of fabric.

Joining instructions (see also photo of finished block):

1. Make the peaks using A and B flying geese method, join C to two of your flying geese.
2. Join the two E strips then cut into 1 and 1/2 strips to make $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
3. Now make your star
4. Join the E blocks to the D's to form the centre block.
5. Then join the two remaining flying geese to this block.
6. Now join A B and C block to complete your star.
