

North Hampshire Quilters Block of the Month

July - Wimbledon Star

12 inch finished

Please read through all instructions before starting your block.

Fabric Requirements:

You will need six colours
A,B,C,D,E,F



Cutting (all measurements are in inches):

A - Cut 4 x 2" squares (A3)

1 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square cut into a triangle (A1)

1 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " square cut into a triangle (A2)

B - Cut 1 x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " square cut into four triangles (B3)

1 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square cut into two triangles (B1)

1 x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " square cut into two triangles (B2)

C - Cut 9 x $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares do not cut these further they are for the flying geese (C2)

1 x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " square cut this into four triangles but you only need two of the triangles.

D - Cut 1 x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " square cut into four triangles (D1 and D3)

4 x 2" squares (D2)

E - Cut 4 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares cut into two triangle each (E1)

F - Cut 1 x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " square for the flying geese do not cut (F1)

8 x $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares cut into two triangles (F2)

4 x 2" squares (F3)

Joining instructions (see also photo of finished block):

1. Make four half square triangles with C2 and F2.
2. Then make the corner block with A3, F3 and the above. Make four of these.
3. With F1 and C2 make four flying geese. Then join each of these flying geese to F2 on either side. Now join B3 to these and then E1.

You should now have four side panels

4. Join C1 to D3, then join to B1. Now make the opposite block and join these two blocks together.
5. Now join B2 to D1 then to D2 on either side. Make two of these and then join these to the centre block.
6. You should now be able to complete the final block with the four corner block, four side blocks and the centre block.

Happy sewing - a challenge but rewarding. Take it with determination just like Andy Murray and you will feel the buzz at the end!
