

Scrap Mystery Quilt Part 3

You should now have two sets of rectangles joined. This month you need to join the third set of rectangles.

Using Scrap

So if you are using scrap you need to join your 2 ½ " square dark together with your 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle.

You should now have 36 newly joined pieces if you are doing the small quilt or 144 pieces if you are doing the large quilt.

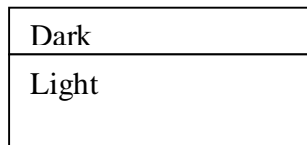
Using yardage

From the ¼ yard dark cut strips 2 ½" wide

From the ½ yard light cut strips 4 ½" wide

Join these two strips together and press towards the dark.

Now cut these into 2 ½" pieces. Continue until you have 36 pieces for the small quilt or 144 pieces for the large quilt.

Using Scrap

Using yardage

From the ¼ yard dark cut strips 2 ½" wide

From the ½ yard light cut strips 4 ½" wide

Join these two strips together and press towards the dark.

Now cut these into 2 ½" pieces. Continue until you have 36 pieces for the small quilt or 144 pieces for the large quilt.
