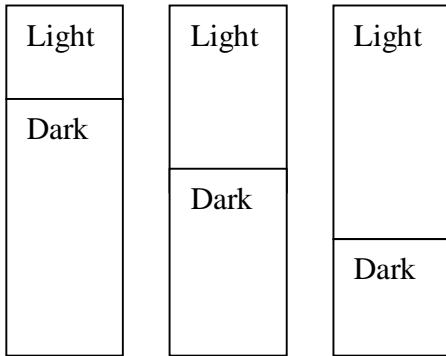


### Mystery Block Part 4

You should now have three different sets of triangles in the combinations of colour ways as below.

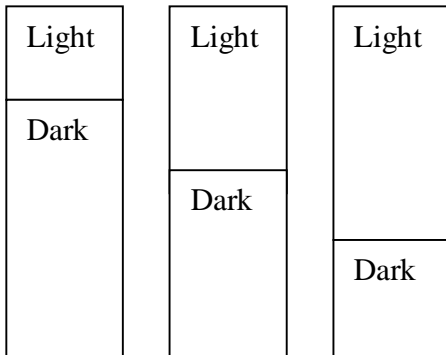


For Part four join the above blocks together as illustrated : The light at the top and the dark at the bottom. You will now have a 6 ½ " square . Join all your blocks this way until you have 36 squares or 144 squares depending on the size of your quilt.

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
