



Prem Baby Quilt – 4 Patch and Squares

Cut two widths of matching material strips – 2 ½" wide

Cut 6 - 4 ½" squares

Cut 1" strips for the inner borders each 12"/16" approx

Cut 2 ½" strips for the outer borders 16" approx

Cut 1 ¼" strips for the binding

Use ¼" seams throughout. Finished quilt measures 16" x 20" approximately.

1. Use 2 ½" strips to make 6 - 4 patch units.
2. Assemble 4 patches and 4 ½" print fabric squares into a quilt top.
3. Use 1" (not 1 ¼") strips for the 1st border.
4. Use 2 ½" print fabric for the outer border.
5. Layer with soft thin wadding and suitable backing and quilt as desired.
6. Use 1 ¼" strips to bind the quilt (Single layer binding).



Prem Baby Quilt – 6 squares bordered

- Cut 6 – 4 ½" squares
- Cut 17 – 4 ½" x 1 ½" strips
- Cut 12 – 1 ½" squares
- Cut 4 – 2 ½" squares
- Cut 2 – 2 ½" x 11 ½" strips
- Cut 2 – 2 ½" x 14" strips
- Cut 1 ¼" strips for the binding

Use ¼" seams throughout. Finished quilt measures 16" x 20" approximately.

1. Use 4 ½" squares of patterned fabric and bind on two sides with 4 ½" x 1 ½" strips.
2. Make strips with 4 ½" x 1 ½" and 1 ½" squares for the binding on the tops and bottoms of the patterned fabric.
3. Assemble the quilt top.
4. Use the 2 ½" squares and the 2 ½" strips to make the outer binding for the quilt top.
5. Layer with soft thin wadding and suitable backing and quilt as desired.
6. Use 1 ¼" strips to bind the quilt (Single layer binding)
