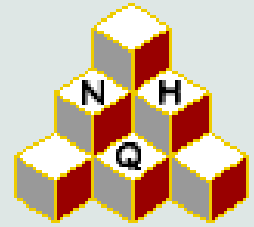

We had requests at the last exhibition for advent calenders in our shop if anyone feels able to make one it would be gratefully received.



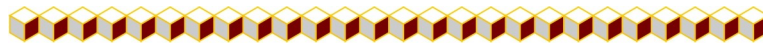
EVEREST
