Baby quilts

We have had a lovely response to the baby quilt night and have a large pile finished already. There is plenty of time to finish any you have on the go from that evening as the aim is to have them finished for our meeting on April 17th when we will have them all out on show.

I have now sorted all the pieces of fabric left from the evening and have a few backings, some breast squares and a pile of 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares that I will bring along to meetings for anyone who can use them.



Oncology quilts

Having got ourselves on track with the baby quilts it would be good to gather a pile of quilts for the oncology ward. Some of the larger donated fabric pieces have already been taken to make these but I have some larger pieces which would be good for these, mainly for backing but some suitable for the fronts. I will start bringing these to the meetings shortly.



Fleece

I have now received the fleece and have, plain cream, pink bunnies, blue stars, and cream with coloured stars.

The cream is $\pounds 6.75$ per metre and the others are $\pounds 7.22$ per metre. This is more than last time but a reduction from $\pounds 8.80$ a metre. As the cream was the most popular I ordered 10 metres which gave extra discount hence the difference in price.
